Details of new license requirements are available at www.qld.gov.au/driving/licence-amendments The main change will be the introduction of the Privacy Act, which is the foundation of the Information Privacy Principle (IPP) and Privacy Amendment (Enhancing Driver Licensing) Act. The Privacy Act is a further development of the Privacy Amendment (Australian Government Collections) Act 2011, which means that more types of information may be stored in a government database than before. This includes information in your driver record, including your photo and details of your birth, physical and mental health, licence history and disqualifications, and non-licence information about your driving history, employment history and financial history. Your existing driver record must be removed from the database and not used for anything except driving purposes. The change is being introduced to protect your privacy, and allow the government to store, manage and use more information about you. What it means for you Your existing driver record will be checked before a new licence is issued. The information in the existing driver record will be compared to that in the new record, and any differences will be highlighted. If the information in the new record is not in your existing record, it will be added to the new record and you will need to have the new record checked before you are granted a new licence. The new system will check your existing driver record against the Department of Transport, Main Roads or other State government databases, and your employment and financial history will also be checked. You will be sent an email to let you know whether there are any changes. If you do not receive the email, please check your junk mail box. What to do if you think there are changes If you are unsure if there are any changes, you should check your existing driver record with the Department of Transport, Main Roads or other relevant government agency.
