

For the rest of the Browns' picks: Round 2, No. 41: CB Jhavonte Dean, Michigan. Dean (6-foot-1, 193 pounds) spent a few years at Michigan after getting out of Warren (Mich.) High School. He spent his first two years of college at Northwestern, but spent the past two at Michigan. He was once an Ohio State commitment, but backed off to avoid competition with Jabrill Peppers. Round 3, No. 71: TE Jeff Heuerman, Ohio State. Heuerman (6-5, 247) is a pretty good blocker who caught 28 passes for 326 yards last year. He didn't wow scouts with his speed, but showed a little after the catch. Round 3, No. 83: S T.J. Green, Clemson. Green (5-10, 203) started his college career at Division II MTSU before transferring to Clemson. At the Senior Bowl, Green was one of the most impressive players. He might not be a shutdown corner, but he shows good instincts and ball skills. He could be a perfect fit for Mike Zimmer's defense, which was a disappointment last year. Round 4, No. 102: S Phillip Gaines, Rice. Gaines (6-0, 200) played safety at Rice and started 38 games. He can be a sideline to sideline defender and can also cover tight ends. Gaines put up great numbers last year, with 102 tackles and an interception. Round 4, No. 107: RB Dontrell Hilliard, Minnesota. Hilliard (5-9, 212) had a promising freshman season at Minnesota, but didn't get much attention coming out of Chicago College. However, he showed well at the Senior Bowl, with 4.49 speed and an impressive display of toughness. Hilliard reminds me of Steelers' fullback Gordon Redinger, in that he's strong and reliable but also good in pass protection. Round 5, No. 142: WR Roderick Johnson, Michigan State. Johnson (6-1, 207) was once committed to Michigan, but ended up going to Michigan State after a move down the depth chart. He played well at the Senior Bowl with an amazing catch that could have gone f3e1b3768c
