The initial release of AutoCAD Activation Code, the standard desktop version, was first offered to individual users at the Winter 1981 CES. At the time, the costs associated with the hardware and software were relatively high; but since the initial version of AutoCAD ran on a microprocessor, AutoCAD was able to fit on a floppy disk (typically 3.5" diskettes) and could operate on a single microcomputer. Not all the core features of AutoCAD were available at the time of its initial release. The version available for purchase at the time of its release included a computer-aided drafting (CAD) feature, but the only sketching tools available were simple lines, circles and arcs. The work area could also be manipulated; however, the only tool available was a line ruler. At the time of release, the program ran on an Apple II or Commodore 64. By the time of the program's 1989 release, AutoCAD had expanded to include three main operating environments: the Mac, the Windows desktop, and AutoCAD LT (included with Mac OS 9 and some Windows systems). AutoCAD also allowed the user to work simultaneously with multiple drawing objects, by which the user could "free draw" in a model without connecting to the computer. Most AutoCAD releases had a Graphics Interchange Format (GIF) version available as an option. (For more on the history of AutoCAD, see the Autodesk 360 page for AutoCAD or the Autodesk Developer Portal for more historical information.) AutoCAD was later released as a completely stand-alone application, and not as a component of the then-new Windows operating system, in 1997. (The application version numbers for this time period are not consecutive, but are not necessarily related to the release date of the operating system.) The Windows 98 release of AutoCAD brought version 200 to AutoCAD, followed by a release of AutoCAD 2009, AutoCAD LT 2007 and AutoCAD 2010 at

version 2010. This was the first AutoCAD release since version 2007. In 2006, Autodesk released an evaluation version of AutoCAD 2009, free of charge. The AutoCAD 2009 service pack, released on December 20, 2007, brought the program's version number up to 2009. There is also a free version of AutoCAD called "AutoCAD LT" available for web browsers as a cross-platform app, for use on

A language called Axapta was formerly used to program the AutoCAD application. It was also extended to create Autodesk Studio and Enterprise Architect applications. AutoCAD supports native integration with Microsoft Windows operating systems through DDE. Direct3D on Windows One of AutoCAD's first native 3D features was support for Direct3D in AutoCAD 2005. AutoCAD natively supports building models and generating meshes. Before AutoCAD natively supported modeling with 3D modeling tools, most work was done with the 3D modeling software 3DS Max. Most 3DS Max content is imported into AutoCAD. AutoCAD natively supports modeling and import of 3D models created in Autodesk 3DMax or Inventor. Although 2D is still the default, AutoCAD natively supports exporting 3D models. AutoCAD 3D is released with AutoCAD LT on Windows.
